## **SWAHILI LANGUAGE & CULTURE**

### **Summer Program**

#### **University of Dar es Salaam**

Students may choose between the 1-month program (no internship) or the 2-month program (with internship). The 1-month program offers intensive Swahili Language and Culture course (6 credits). The 2-month program also includes an internship (3 credits).

The Swahili Language and Culture Course is offered by the Department of Swahili. Internships are organized based on student interests and availability of positions.

Consult with your academic and/or study abroad advisor regarding your course selections. Obtain credit transfer approval from your university.

### **SWAHILI LANGUAGE & CULTURE**

The courses cover all basic aspects of Swahili vocabulary and grammar, and they equip participants with some cultural information.

Method: Lectures, short conversations involving situational/role taking, language laboratory drills, videos, films, daily exercises, etc. There are also trips to Bagamoyo, Zanzibar and Mikumi game reserve. Students should be able to converse, read and write at the basic level after the course.

All exercises and tests are marked and graded. At the end of the course there is an examination. Students who pass get credits for the course taken. Those who do not need credits are not required to sit for the examination.

- **Elementary Swahili**            20 hours per week.
- **Intermediate Swahili**        20 hours per week
- **Advanced Swahili**            20 hours per week.
