The program includes tuition, housing, medical and travel insurance, airport welcome, orientation, on-site support, mobile phone and cultural excursions.

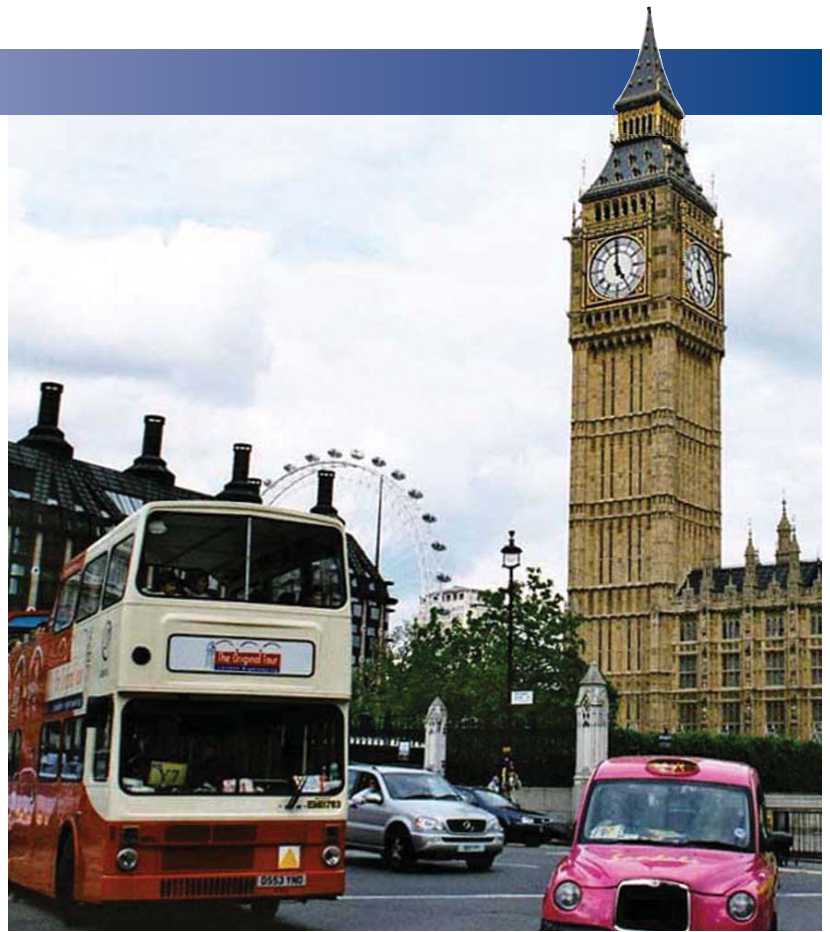

ON-SITE SUPPORT

ACADEMICS
