COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this class, you will be engaged in both individual and group work designed to give you grammatical and conversational basic abilities. Outside of class, you will have independent work and exercises on a regular basis from the Grammaire Progressive du Français, in order to strengthen skills acquired in class. You will have an introduction to the French language and French culture. For this course, you are required to know and be comfortable with: the présent, the passé composé and the imparfait.

- Revision of the présent tense
- Le passé composé and the imparfait
- Les pronoms compléments à tous les temps
- Les relatifs
- Les prépositions et les verbes
- Le conditionnel

- Give and ask for current information
- Talk in the past without difficulties and with logic
- Express regrets and wishes



- Explain plan in the future
- Develop an argument
- Being able to present in public a topic and respond to questions
