

## ACCF LAVA 490 Latest Trends in Visual Arts

Program	Three-year course in Fashion Design, Design, Photography
Course	Latest trends in visual art
Course Description	This course offers a very dynamic approach, workshop-like, focusing on the analysis of the most recent art trends. Research and analysis will largely be carried out directly on the sources, namely through contemporary art works and exhibits, interviews and statements by the artists themselves, and their most important art projects. The national and international scene will be explored, without of course excluding the local context, with critical readings and insights in a real " work in progress." The course will inspire students to search for a personal orientation in the increasingly complex scenario of current visual arts.
Learning Objectives and Outcomes	At the end of the course the student will be able to: 1. Demonstrate a confident knowledge of contemporary art trends. 2. Analyze contemporary art in a theoretical and critical way.
Student Assessment	<ul> <li>The course consists of a combination of various learning experiences: lectures, visits, readings, class discussions, slide and video projections. The students' active participation is expected.</li> <li>The student will be evaluated on his/her ability to: <ul> <li>Present coherent persuasive arguments in written and oral form.</li> <li>Successfully conduct individual research on pre-assigned topics.</li> <li>Express a critical opinion in a confident way.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The student's final grade will be composed of: <ul> <li>25% Mid-term exam</li> <li>25% Final exam</li> <li>20% Oral presentation</li> <li>30% Final project</li> </ul> </li> <li>1. MID TERM AND FINAL WRITTEN EXAMS <ul> <li>Both exams consist of an essay test on the topics studied during the course.</li> </ul> </li> <li>2. ORAL PRESENTATION <ul> <li>As home assignments, students will prepare an oral and written analysis of an artist related to the topics studied in class.</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. FINAL PROJECT <ul> <li>The group final project consists of a research paper which will focus on specific aspects of contemporary visual arts. The topic will be proposed by the student and approved by the teacher. The project may also consist of the preparation of a personal study book, documenting the student's creative research and association paths, to explore the vast field of contemporary art production and reflection.</li> <li>Students can choose whether to make the final project in paper format or by designing one specific multimedia project.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
