Course Description	<p>The student will learn some different techniques related to textile printing and will make creative impressions on fabric. The three techniques we will practice during the course are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Linocut/block printing on fabric- Mono printing on fabric- Stencil on fabric <p>The lessons will be mostly practical, including slides and explanations. Students will improve their knowledge of mark-making on fabric to reach a professional level of skill.</p>
