| Learning Outcomes: | By the end of the course students will be able to: <br> - Correctly draw stylized technical sketches of the human figure (both male and female) in different positions (frontal, side, back, in movement) appropriate for illustrating fashion designs; <br> - Develop a personalized, skillful and quick illustrative technique for the visual interpretation of colored illustrative fashion designs depicted on the human figure; <br> - Apply technical and coloring skills to drawn figures to visually represent their collections in an expressive way. |  |
